This **40.05-metre Sunseeker 131** combines impressive performance with a particularly versatile seven-cabin layout and extensive spaces for entertaining.

Built by Sunseeker in the United Kingdom and delivered in 2010, she offers an impressive **331 GT** of volume across multiple guest decks while retaining the sleek profile and performance for which Sunseeker's large motor yachts are renowned.

In **2026, the yacht underwent an extensive exterior refit**, including a **complete exterior repaint, renewal of the exterior teak decking and comprehensive hull maintenance**. The works significantly refreshed her exterior presentation while maintaining the distinctive character of this highly successful Sunseeker design.

Exceptional Seven-Cabin Layout

One of the yacht's defining features is her unusually generous accommodation.

She offers **seven guest cabins**, comprising a full-beam Master Suite on the main deck, two additional Double/VIP cabins and four Twin cabins.

The layout provides exceptional flexibility for large families, private guests or charter operation and makes particularly effective use of the yacht's substantial 331 GT interior volume.

The main saloon benefits from **fold-down balconies to both port and starboard**, creating additional exterior spaces directly over the water and providing a seamless connection between the interior and surrounding sea.

Her upper decks provide extensive areas for entertaining, dining and relaxing. The sundeck features a **Jacuzzi**, generous lounging areas and ample space for social occasions, while more private areas throughout the yacht allow guests to retreat when desired.

Performance

Powered by **twin MTU 16V 4000 M93L diesel engines**, producing approximately **4,000 HP each and 8,000 HP combined**, she combines substantial volume with impressive performance.

With a maximum speed of approximately **30 knots**, this Sunseeker offers the space and accommodation expected of a 40-metre superyacht while retaining the performance-oriented character of the brand.
